What is the CBF <u>Offering</u> for <u>Global Missions?</u>

The OGM is the primary giving channel for supporting CBF field personnel and their ministries. Orange Baptist members have two opportunities to give to the OGM, in December and again in March, when special offerings are taken.

Giving to missions through the OGM is an act of stewardship and ensures a consistent missions presence around the world. The Offering is the primary way field personnel are funded. Field personnel depend on and are encouraged by our financial gifts. However, in recent years the Offering has not been sufficient to support all field personnel. The result is some field personnel are forced to spend time away from their ministry sites to raise funds to support their ministry.

The Offering for Global Missions across the Fellowship averages \$4 million per year. The amount needed to support all field personnel, including those who raise their own support, is \$5.5 million. Estimates reveal that if approximately <u>"half (around 900) of the churches in the</u> <u>Fellowship network would give just \$1,500 more per</u> <u>year"</u> all personnel could be supported! Orange Baptist, can we become more engaged??

Prayerfully consider giving sacrificially and generously to the Offering for Global Missions throughout December. Look for special envelopes in your box of envelopes and in the pew racks. Our goal is \$3,200.
