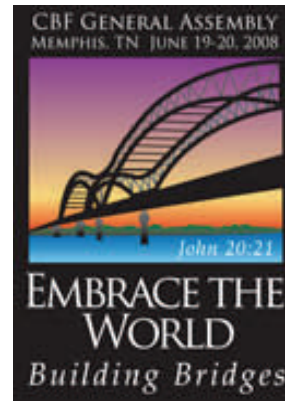

OBC is housing volunteers from White Stone Nazarene Church the week of June 15-20 who will be working at Sheltering Arms Homeless Shelter. We are grateful for their ministry among us and are happy to partner with them. The volunteers will be lodging and preparing their meals in our facility. They will be using the showers at the Hornets Sports Center.
